Who is this Diploma for?

Is this Diploma recognised?

What Subjects are required to complete the Diploma?

To complete the Diploma a total of 12 Subjects (formally known as Units of Competencies) are required to be completed.

Are there any prerequisites and enrolment requirements?

Preferred pathways for candidates considering this qualification include:

BSB41515 Certificate IV in Project Management Practice OR extensive vocational experience in project roles where they may have had some limited responsibility for the output of others but do not have a formal project management qualification. Though not an enrolment requirement you may also need to find someone to mentor you.

To enrol you need to satisfy the following enrolment requirements

1. Access to a relevant complex project that you will manage.
2. A computer with email access, internet access, a word processor program and a spread sheet program and the ability to use these programs. An A4 printer and an A4 scanner.

How will I learn?

Learning is by mixed mode with face to face and/or online workshops and distance and includes using the provided learning material, undertaking pre-workshop tasks, attending workshops, research, undertaking project management tasks and undertaking assessments. Undertaking assessments is an essential part of the learning process. There are 12 half day workshops and these are held in Sydney and Online. Contact us for dates of workshops.

What sort of assessments are there?

Assessments depend on the subject and can include research assignments, observation by an assessor, practical assessments, undertaking design projects and/or annual certification projects, workplace projects and third party reports.

How long will it take to complete?

The time required will depend on your existing skills and available time to undertake studies. As a guide for someone with limited experience will take between approximately 600 hours to complete. The Diploma is delivered over 2 semesters with 2 semesters per year. This Diploma must be completed within 1 year of enrolment.

Can I get RPL if I already have the required skills and knowledge?

Yes, your previous learning and current work experience may be used to satisfy all or some of the course requirements by using a Recognition of Previous Learning (RPL) process or alternatively you may undertake the Assessment only option. Contact us for further information.

How much are the course fees are when are they paid? (prices at 01/01/17)

For this Diploma the course fees are \$2,500
